Now I Can See Blind Outreach Center,
Redeemer Lutheran Church, Springfield \$4,300



As a newly formed ministry of Redeemer Lutheran Church in Springfield, Now I Can See Outreach Center provides services that make a big difference in the lives of visually impaired or blind people. The Center is asking for LWML mites to specifically help with four of the projects in the next two years: 1) Provide registration and expenses for three visually impaired or blind people to attend two annual Christian Blind Institute Conferences for the purpose of training them to assume leadership in their Outreach Center and their personal lives; 2) Purchase twenty electronic Bibles that are not available in the

public market from Braille Bibles International; 3) Provide for four field trips that could incur admission or transportation cost (concerts, theater trips museums with hands-on exhibits etc.) and visit nursing homes to sing or visit with residents; and 4) Provide for supplies and meals for monthly meetings that are not covered out of Redeemer Lutheran Church's general budget.
