

Lutheran Women's Missionary League Missouri District 25th Biennial Convention – June 8-10, 2018 Registration Instructions and Information

Basic Instructions for Completing the Registration Form

- We advise you to read all of the following information carefully. If you have any questions, contact Nancy Doering, Convention Registrar, at doering2018reg@gmail.com or text/call 573-694-2508, or seek the help of your society or zone president.
- The Registration Form can be found at the www.missourilwml.org website. It can be downloaded, printed and filled out by hand, or downloaded and filled out electronically on your computer by using the TAB key to move from blank to blank. Be sure you check and/or circle responses when required. When finished, print the form.
- Registration begins on February 1, 2018. Registrations for voting members and alternates must be postmarked on or before April 14, 2018. Registrations for all others should be postmarked on or before May 1, 2018. The registration fee increases for registrations postmarked after May 1, 2018, or completed in person at the convention. Please register early!
- NEW at this convention: the mandatory Health Information and Waiver Forms are included with the Registration Form and must be completed and returned with your registration documents. These forms are also on the District website.
- After completing the Registration, Health Information, and Waiver forms, **make a copy of each for your records** before mailing your completed Registration Form, Health Information Form, Waiver Form, your payment and a <u>self-addressed</u>, <u>stamped business-size envelope</u> to Nancy Doering, Registrar, 2014 Autumn Lane, Jefferson City, MO 65109. It is important that you include everything requested. Incomplete registrations will be returned, thus delaying your registration process. Keep this *Registration Instructions and Information* document for future reference. <u>You will receive an acknowledgement of registration</u> via USPS. After May 16, 2018, you must register in person at the convention.

Registration Check-in

- On Friday, the registration tables will be in the Valencia Room at the Lodge. There will be separate lines for different registrant categories (for example, voting members). Pay attention to the signs to avoid delays. You must check in and receive your credentials unless you are a member of the District Board. District Board members receive their credentials, tote bags, etc. at the luncheon on Friday.
- Tote bags, convention shirts, pins and charms will also be in the Valencia Room on Friday.
- On Saturday, registration check-in will be in the Campana Hall lobby only. This is the main meeting hall across the drive from the Lodge's main lobby entrance. Totes, shirts and jewelry will also be in the Campana Hall lobby on Saturday.

Online Voting (for voting members only)

- A voting member must provide her current email address on the Registration Form. Proofread for accuracy please.
- If your email address changes after mailing your Registration Form, immediately contact Ashley Kassel at alkassel1s@gmail.com or 573-986-8009.
- Voting for mission project grants will be held <u>online prior to the convention only</u>. <u>Mission project grants will not be voted on at</u> the convention.
- Online voting for grants will be open between 12:01 a.m. May 20, 2018, through midnight on May 26, 2018.
- Voting for elected positions will be held during the convention only.
- On the Registration Form, indicate if you will use your own device (smartphone, iPad, laptop, etc.) to vote for elected positions at the convention or if you will use the convention computer lab. Assistance will be provided in the computer lab.

Meals

- If you have food allergies, be sure to list them on the Registration Form (lower right hand corner).
- All convention meals must be paid in advance at the time of registration.
- Be sure to circle your meal choice on the registration form when a choice is offered.

Saturday Banquet and Entertainment

• Plan to attend the "Starlight Sparkle" [Philippians 2:14-16] banquet in the Granada Room where you are invited to be a "SPARKLER" by wearing all your sparkles! We will be entertained by "The MAKER'S Dozen" as they play and sing bluegrass and gospel music to benefit Immanuel Lutheran School in Honey Creek. There will be a love offering for "The MAKER'S Dozen." They will also have CDs available for sale. Our YWRs will lead the celebration of our 25th biennial convention which means 50 years of LWML in Missouri! After the celebration, you will be invited either to stay in the Granada Room for fellowship or move to the rooftop outside the Valencia Room where the YWRs are in charge of the music. There will be a cash bar serving coffee and tea.

Mission Walk

- Micah 4:5 "For all the peoples walk each in the name of its god, but we will walk in the name of the LORD our God forever and ever." WALKING IN HIS NAME was chosen as the theme for the mission walk. Join the walk outside on Saturday morning or join the indoor class—it's great exercise and raises money for mites. Walkers will receive a T-shirt-shaped water bottle, snacks and logo bracelets. Include the \$10 fee with your registration at No. 8 on the Registration Form.
- Everyone who participates in a "Second-Ever Society Opportunity" prior to convention will get the bracelet only.

Convention Jewelry

Your choice of a lapel pin or charm with the convention logo is available. Pins and charms are \$5.00 each. Choose either or both. Circle your choice on the Registration Form and include payment with your registration.

Shirts

There are two choices this year: a polyester V-neck Polo shirt with collar and embroidered with the convention logo, "He Knows My Name" Isaiah 43:1, or a round neck T-shirt with a screen-printed logo. Both shirts are in the convention color of turquoise. Indicate on the Registration Form which shirt(s) you want, including size. Include payment with your registration.
